The Euroarab Foundation for Higher Studies, **in the aim of supporting research programmes on renewable energies as an instrument for the achievement of sustainable development in MENA countries**, invites academics, scientists, researchers and specialized technicians from these countries to apply for a Euroarab Chair on Renewable Energies, with the sponsorship of the Spanish Agency for International Development Cooperation (AECID).

» Terms

First.- The present call for applications aims at awarding a Chair on Renewable Energies to academics, researchers, scientists and specialized technicians from MENA countries willing to culminate a research programme dealing with renewable energies as an instrument for the achievement of sustainable development on MENA countries, to be carried out during an academic, research and scientific stay of **3 months** at the Euroarab Foundation head office.

Second.- The call for applications **begins on March 1st, 2009 and ends on June 1st, 2009**. Please, send your application to the Euroarab Foundation of Higher Studies by e-mail. Please

attach the following documents in Spanish, English or French:

- a) Application form duly filled in, including a description on the research topic to be developed on the field of renewable energies (download from Web site: www.fundea.org).
- b) CV with a photograph.
- c) Two letters of academic recommendation.
- d) Description of the programme to be developed (1500 words maximum), which shall include research, training and/or information activities on the research topic: renewable energies as an instrument for sustainable development in the MENA countries.

The applicants are informed and accept the inclusion of the personal data included in this form in an automated data file, as well as its automatic processing during the completion, resolution and announcement of Chair's final recipient.

» Third.- The recipient's obligations

- a) To join the Chair Programme and stay in Granada **from September 1st until November 30th, 2009**.
- b) To carry out a research on the proposed topic, whose result will have a physical manifestation. The Foundation will be responsible for its spreading and it will become part of the Foundation's batches of documents. All the items produced during the project shall include the logos of the Euroarab Foundation and the AECID.
- c) To propose a **programme of activities** such as lectures, round tables and exhibitions at the Euroarab Foundation head office and/or in the agreed upon cities and institutions during the stay in Granada.

Total or partial breach of these terms may result in cancellation of the grant. In the case of non-respect of these conditions the applicant may pay back the total amount of the grant.

» Fourth.- Recipient's rights

- a) To receive a monthly payment of €3,000 gross (up to €9,000 gross) that will not be considered as a salary. The payment of the grant will be made directly to the recipients who shall have an account in any bank located within Spanish territory.
 - b) Covered accommodation and travel expenses.
 - c) To receive from the Euroarab Foundation the necessary collaboration and support for the achievement of the Programme goals.
- Fifth.-** Selection by the Programme Academic Board will be based on the academic, professional and research experience of the applicants as well as on the quality of the proposed project and the research planning.

The presentation of the application implies the acceptance of its terms and of the decisions of the Euroarab Foundation concerning this Programme, which will not be open to appeal.
